Good news and not-so-good news!

The good news is that:

- ❖ 44 letters were received by
Broadland District council in support
of our application and only 10
against.
- ❖ Brundall Parish Council agreed to
support the application, with some
concerns (which are being
addressed)
- ❖ Broadland District Council has
agreed to extending the consultation
period relating to our application until
we can have bat surveys carried out.

The not-so-good news is that the bat
surveys cannot be carried out until May/
June so the process may not move along
again until July or August.
