Bee thankful this Harvest time. Help Christian bee-keepers in Uganda.

Money given in our churches this Harvest will go to Barnabas Fund to enable Christians from a Muslim background to set up small bee-keeping enterprises to support themselves. They live in a part of Uganda that is around 90% Muslim, where food scarcity is a recurring problem, where almost all the shops in the local town belong to Muslims, and where anti-Christian violence has occurred a number of times. Converts from Islam suffer persecution from their Muslim relatives. The grant covers a 30-day training course that combines bee-keeping and Bible study and supplies the hives and other equipment that they need
