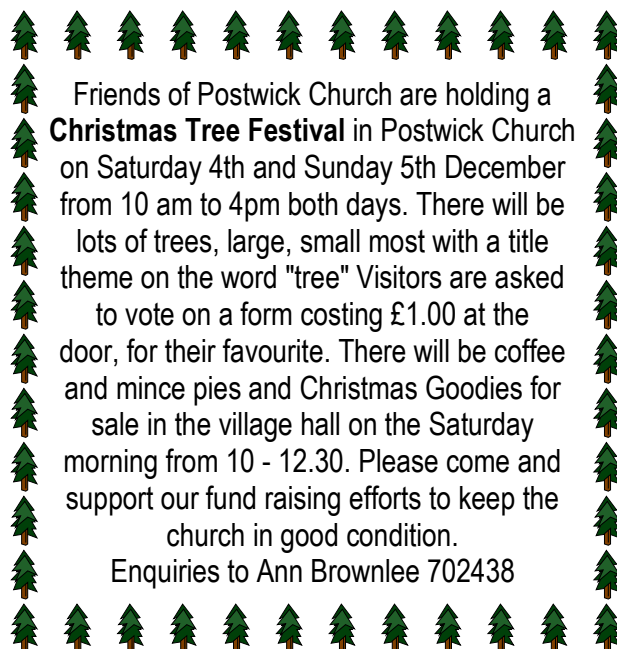
Volunteers needed
