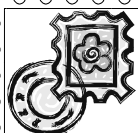
Brundall Church development Saturday 8 January 2011 10am-3pm.

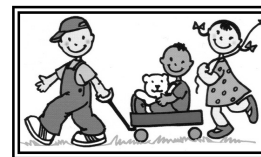
