Thank you to all those who wrote to the PCC with comments. All comments were considered and after considerable discussion, the PCC decided to re-submit the current plans (with some alterations to take into account some of the issues raised in relation to the present plans) for Planning Permission.

The Church's Mission Giving this year has been allocated to Norwich YMCA, the Vidiyal Trust, Wycliffe Bible Translators (Eastern Congo group) and the Church Pastoral Aid Society (receiving £600 each), the 4 charities working to support the persecuted church that are supported by our Ichthus Group (who share £600), the Hilary Critten Fund (£500) and the Children's Society (£400). These varied organisations were nominated by the Church family and allow us to share some of the blessings we have received with those in need locally, nationally or internationally.

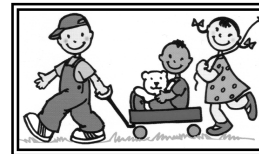
