Brundall Church Development
 - an update from the Feasibility Group
 (chairman Dave Carding)

What is it for? To look afresh at ways of providing St Laurence Church with the facilities it needs

How are we doing that? By looking carefully at our needs, re-visiting earlier suggestions and thinking of likely (& unlikely) solutions, and their pros & cons

How far have we got? As a first step we are looking into 4 options:

- ◆ extending the North Aisle to level with the back of the existing extension, and/or
- ◆ a new single-storey building with rooms, kitchen & modern toilet facilities parallel with the N. Aisle and possibly linked to the church
- ◆ a similar new build near the lych-gate
- ◆ finding an alternative Rectory and extending & developing the existing Rectory and site to provide rooms & facilities, together with good parking

and we have had a site meeting with Bishop Alan & the Archdeacon

What is our next step? A meeting with representatives from Broadland DC and the Diocesan Advisory Committee

What can the Church Family do? Please keep praying, and sharing your thoughts & ideas with us, and look out for further updates
