### **The letter of St Paul to the Romans.**

**Key verses:** Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is true worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will. (12v1,2)  
Love must be sincere. (12v9)

**Key thoughts:** By the end of chapter 11 St Paul has completed his explanation of God's great rescue plan for humanity. In chapters 12-16 he turns to the practical outworking of God's plan in our lives.

The first part of our response to His great love is to give our whole beings to God, and the second is to love one another sincerely, not play acting but actively looking out for the interests of others. Not easy, but possible because of 'the love of God which has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit'. The lectionary readings have omitted some bits of Romans. Those passages are also important so do try and take time to read and reflect on them as well.
